

1. For breakfast, 4 campers equally share 1 grapefruit that is divided into 4 sections. Which number sentence below shows the number of sections of grapefruit each camper will get?

A $4 \div 4 = 1$

B $4 \div 1 = 4$

C $0 \div 4 = 0$

D $8 \div 2 = 4$

3. Which number sentence shows how many people can have one slice of a pie that is divided into 8 slices?

A $8 \div 8 = 1$

B $8 \div 1 = 8$

C $8 \div 4 = 2$

D $8 \div 2 = 4$

4. **Writing to Explain** Luke has a foot-long sandwich that is cut into 6 pieces. How many people can have a piece of the sandwich? Write a number sentence to show how many people can have a piece of the sandwich. Explain your answer.

2. There are 6 slices of cantaloupe. Jerome gave an equal number of slices of cantaloupe to his 6 friends. Which number sentence below shows the number of slices of cantaloupe each of his friends received?

A $6 \div 6 = 1$

B $6 \div 1 = 6$

C $12 \div 1 = 12$

D $12 \div 12 = 1$
